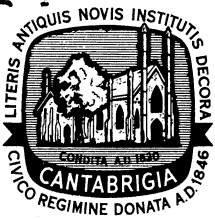


Re: Special Appropriation

An additional appropriation in the amount of \$112.00 to be credited to C-9, Office Equipment, is hereby requested in the 1972 License Commission Budget.

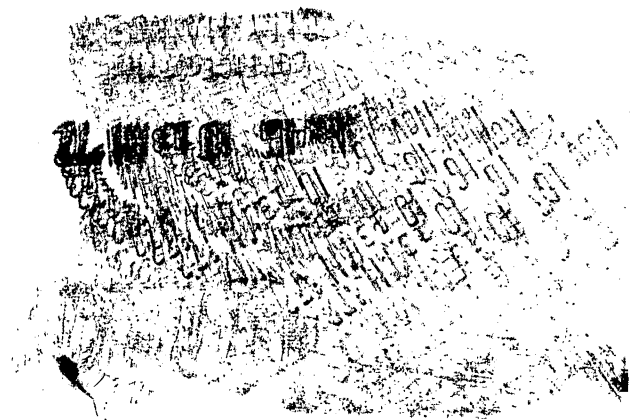
This request is necessitated because by the time the company received the purchase order, the machine was not being manufactured any longer; therefore, the next nearest machine was ordered.

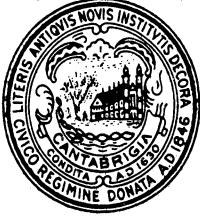


