- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Leslie MacLeod, Director of the Cambridge Hospital has recently resigned from the service of the City, completing twenty years of public service; and
- WHEREAS: Les first came to the service of the City as a temporary male attendant on January 15, 1961 and worked in this capacity until January 29, 1965, when he became a part-time male attendant and on July 1, 1965 he was appointed as a fourth year administrative resident serving in that capacity until August 27, 1969, at which time he was appointed administrative assistant for Professional Services, holding that position until January 1, 1970, when he became Hospital Director; and
- WHEREAS: During his long tenure Les continued his education, having obtained a Bachelor of Arts Degree from Boston College, a Master's Degree in Public Health from Yale University and Harvard University; and
- WHEREAS: Les has resigned from his position as Hospital Director in order to assume a similar position at Higgins Hospital in Wolfeboro, New Hampshire; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending it's deep appreciation to Leslie MacLeod for his long tenure of dedicated public service to the people of Cambridge and to further wish him well in his new endeavor at Higgins Hospital; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation to Mr. MacLeod a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution on behalf of the entire City Council.
