The arts council, through the festival, has initiated the seeds of a new and self expanding dialogue between the city and its communities.

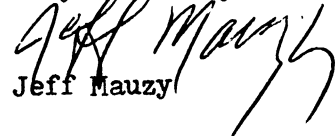
