ORDERED:

That Superintendent's Recommendation (unnumbered), dated March 1, 1983, relative to the Use of Public School Gymnasiums by Private Schools, be adopted and made part of the Rules of the School Committee as follows: that it be the policy of the Cambridge School Committee that any Cambridge private secondary school may have rent-free use of a Cambridge Public School gymnasium, provided that:

- (a) said private school does not have its own gymnasium;
- (b) 50% or more of said private school's students are Cambridge residents;
- (c) no admission is charged to the event or activity for which the gymnasium is used;
- (d) such use does not in any way interfere with any use scheduled by the Cambridge Public Schools;
- (e) all other requirements and provisions for use by an outside agency are met, including custodial, maintenance and other costs.

If for any reason, any one of provisions (a), (b), or (c) cannot be met, the usual rental fee will be charged.
