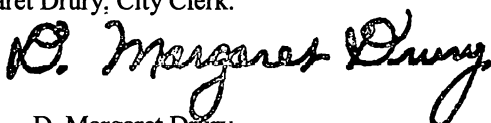
- WHEREAS: The month of October has been recognized as National Arts and Humanities Month by thousands of arts and cultural organizations, communities, and states across the country as well as by the White House and Congress for more than a decade; and
- WHEREAS: The arts and humanities embody much of the accumulated wisdom, intellect, and imagination of humankind; and
- WHEREAS: The arts and humanities enhance and enrich the lives of every American; and
- WHEREAS: The arts and humanities play a unique role in the lives of our families, our communities, and our country; and
- WHEREAS: The nonprofit arts industry also strengthens our economy by generating \$134 billion in economic activity annually and by supporting the full-time equivalent of 4.85 million jobs; and
- WHEREAS: The United States Conference of Mayors passed unanimously in June 2004, a policy resolution to urge mayors and other elected officials to proclaim October as National Arts and Humanities Month; now therefore be it:
- RESOLVED: That this City Council proclaim October 2004 as National Arts and Humanities Month in the City of Cambridge, Massachusetts and call upon our citizens to celebrate and promote the arts and culture in our nation and to specifically encourage the greater participation by those said citizens in taking action for the arts and humanities in Cambridge; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the U.S. Conference of Mayors on behalf of the entire City Council.
