WHEREAS: On April 24 and 25, 1999, the National Holocaust Museum will host "Gays and Lesbians Under Nazi Rule;" and

WHEREAS: The program is sponsored by the Chicago Gay and Lesbian Project of the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum and chaired by Michael Bauer and Denise C. Foy; and

WHEREAS: From 1933 to 1945, the Nazis arrested approximately 100,000 people because of their sexual orientation, most of whom spent time in prison; an estimated 5,000-15,000 were sent to concentration camps; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record expressing its appreciation to Michael Bauer and Denise C. Foy, the Chicago Gay and Lesbian Project, and the National Holocaust Museum for presenting this important program; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Michael Bauer, Denise Foy, the Chicago Gay and Lesbian Project and the National Holocaust Museum on behalf of the entire City Council.

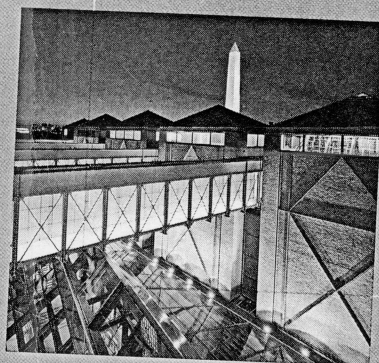
AIR AND HOTEL RATES:

There is a program fee of \$65 per person to cover the cost of the dinner and program materials.

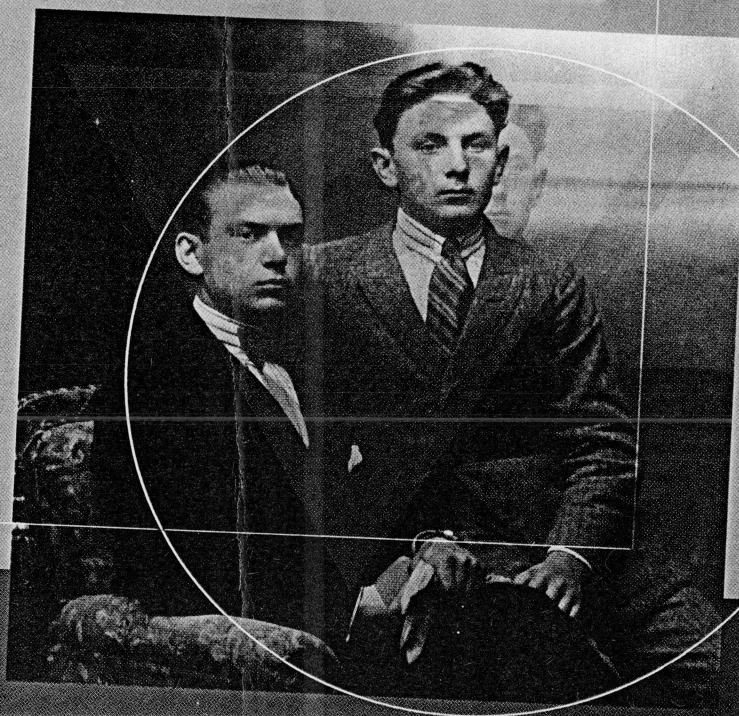
