

We, the undersigned, owners of land through which it is proposed to extend Green Street in the City of Cambridge, and owners of land on said street abutting on that part of Green St. proposed to be widened; in consideration of No Dollar to us paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for other good and valuable considerations, hereby for ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, severally promise and agree, to and with the City of Cambridge, that neither we, nor any person claiming by, through, or under us, shall make any claim for damages for land taken or to be taken by the City for the widening and extension of said Green Street, or the filling of same to grade; Provided said extension, widening and filling is made during the present year.
