The following projects are proposed to be funded with reprogrammed current year Block Grant funds. Funds for Teen Camping & Sanctuary would be available from cancellation of project G-32, Family Life Counselling Services and Training. The cancelled project was local share for a Title XX program which did not obtain state approval. Funds for the Boys' Club service project would be shifted from funds allocated for Boys' Club Facility improvements.

In accordance with the Citizen Participation Plan, you have fifteen days from the above date in which to comment upon these proposed projects; after this time a final decision will be made.

1. CAMBRIDGE TEEN CAMPING PROGRAM - \$6,000

This program, similar to the one operated last summer, provides weekend camping experiences for lower income youth. The youth are referred to the program by a variety of existing youth service agencies. The program will be run by Cambridge Community Schools, with last year's program director (Tracy deNagy of Sanctuary) serving as a consultant.

2. SANCTUARY LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM-\$10,000

This program provides challenging outdoor experiences of four weeks duration for potentially delinquent boys and girls.

3. EAST CAMBRIDGE BOY'S CLUB HUMAN SERVICE PROJECT- \$3,000

This project will provide expanded staffing for the East Cambridge Boy's Club over a one-year period.
