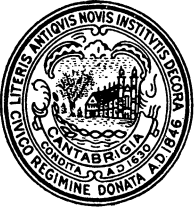

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$2,903.00 to reimburse William Crocker, an employee of the Electrical Department for damages in this amount.

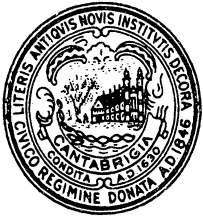
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against William Crocker in which there was a judgment of \$2,903.00.


To the Honorable, the City Council,
