2. 51 out of 100 nominating signatures rejected because on the wrong paper in direct violation of the Jack E. Robinson Case of I believe 1998 concerning the Black Republican candidate for governor.

Forcing 40 signatures to be gotten in a two hour period instead of a month.

3. "Veteran" status kept off name on the ballot.

Total denial of a basic legal right.

Cambridge has contempt for the environment, for all living creatures within its boundaries, for the trees, for the vegetation, for the wetlands for itself, for truth.

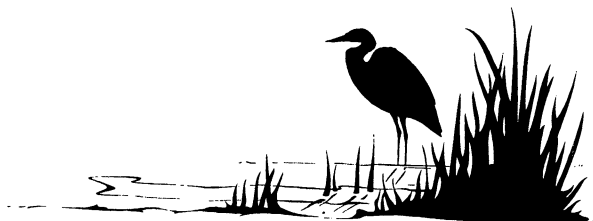
Cambridge has contempt for the rule of law.
