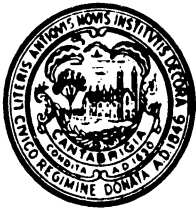

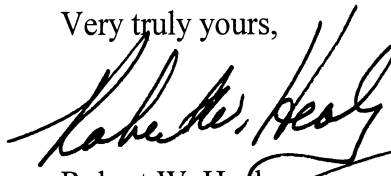

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$8,780.00 in the Grant Fund of the Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$5,040.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$3,740.00). The Cambridge Friends of the Council on Aging have awarded the Council on Aging these funds to operate a reassurance network for seniors. This program involves establishing and maintaining contact with homebound and other isolated seniors for regular telephone check-ins. The program also allows for the delivery of food items to those seniors eligible for the Food Pantry who cannot get to the pantry at the Citywide Senior Center. The funds will be used to help cover the salary of a coordinator and bus driver as well as operating supplies.
