- WHEREAS: This City Council wishes to remember one of its late life-long residents and deceased war hero, one, John M. Moriarty, Jr.; and
- WHEREAS: John attended local public schools and Boston College, prior to entering the United States Army in 1943 serving in World War II until the time of his death during the Battle of the Bulge on January 14, 1945; and
- WHEREAS: This kind of total commitment of someone who gave his life for his country should not go unnoticed; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record naming the corner of Hutchinson and Appleton Streets as "PFC John M. Moriarty, Jr. Square" to serve as a lasting memorial to this man's patriotism; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to prepare the appropriate sign and make the necessary arrangements for a suitable dedication ceremony; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Moriarty family on behalf of the entire City Council.
