- WHEREAS: On The Rise, Inc. will be holding its Prepare for Winter Dinner, with special guest Jacki Lyden, author of *Daughter of the Queen of Sheba*, the Senior Correspondent for National Public Radio's *Weekend All Things Considered*, winner of the National Press Club Award and the National Mental Health Association Media Award, and Lucy Murray-Brown, member of the Cambridge Community Foundation and the Guidance Center, Inc., who will be receiving the 5th Annual Beryl H. Bunker Award, for her outstanding professional and volunteer work on behalf of women and women's organizations in and around Cambridge and Boston; and
