ORDERED:-

That His Honor the Mayor be and hereby is authorized, in the name of and in behalf of the City of Cambridge, to sell and convey to Patrick J. Joyce, for a sum not less than Six Hundred Dollars (\$600) a parcel of land situated and described as follows:-

Beginning at a point in the southerly line of Vassal Lane at the division line between lots numbered 101 and 102, said point being one hundred seventy and thirty-two hundredths (170.32) feet westerly from the westerly line of Chilton Street;- thence southerly along the said division line between lots numbered 101 and 102, ninety-two and eighty-eight hundredths (92.88) feet to a corner;- thence westerly along the division line between lots numbered 101 and 107, twenty-six and forty-one hundredths (26.41) feet to a corner;- thence northwesterly along the division line between lots numbered 101 and 189, one hundred twelve and twenty-five hundredths (112.25) feet to the southerly line of Vassal Lane;- thence easterly along the said southerly line of Vassal Lane, eighty-two and fifty-six hundredths (82.56) feet to the point of beginning.
