- WHEREAS: Ralph was born in Cambridge on July 21, 1915, attended local schools and later served his country during World War II and, while in the service, was notified of his appointment to the Fire Department on November 30, 1941; and
- WHEREAS: Upon his honorable discharge, Ralph was assigned to Engine 7 on December 16, 1945, an assignment he maintained until receiving injuries from which he was forced to retire on April 1, 1954; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Margaret Diehl and family at Ralph's passing; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Diehl on behalf of the entire City Council.
