WHEREAS: An extremely dangerous situation exists along the sidewalk at # 38 Matignon Road, Cambridge as a result of a large hole not having been filled in after removal of a tree and, in the same location, the roots of a tree are pushing up through the sidewalk, damaging its surface, and has been the site of several slip and fall accidents; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager direct the DPW Commissioner to assign personnel from the Department's appropriate divisions to resolve these problems. Further, that the City Manager report back to this Council at the regularly scheduled Council Session on October 24, 1988 to confirm completion of same or to advise to the shortest period of time anticipated within which completion will be effected.
