AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CAMBRIDGE PUBLIC HEALTH COMMISSION

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 147 of the Acts of 1996 is hereby amended in Section 3, subsection (f) by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:

Except as otherwise provided in this act, chapters thirty-one, thirty-two, thirty-two B, and two hundred sixty-eight A of the General Laws and all other provisions of law applicable to government entities but inapplicable to non-profit corporations, shall not apply to the operations and employees of Somerville Hospital upon acquisition or management thereof by the city or the commission, for so long as Somerville Hospital shall be construed as a non-profit corporation, nor shall said chapters and provisions apply to any other non-profit corporation owned or controlled by the commission.

SECTION 2. Chapter 147 of the Acts of 1996 is hereby amended in Section 3, subsection (f) by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

Chapter 150 E shall apply to employees of Somerville Hospital upon the acquisition or management thereof by the city or the commission and said chapter and provisions shall apply to any other non-profit corporation owned or controlled by the commission.

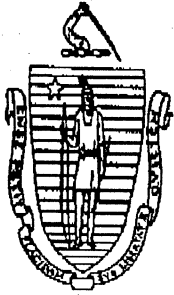

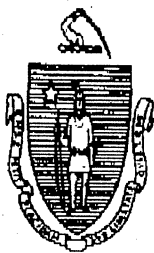

AN ACT

RELATIVE TO THE CAMBRIDGE PUBLIC HEALTH COMMISSION

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 147 of the Acts of 1996 is hereby amended in Section 3, subsection (f) by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:

Except as otherwise provided in this act, chapters thirty-one, thirty-two, thirty-two B, and two hundred sixty-eight A of the General Laws and all other provisions of law applicable to government entities but inapplicable to non-profit corporations, shall not apply to the operations and employees of Somerville Hospital upon acquisition or management thereof by the city or the commission, for so long as Somerville Hospital shall be construed as a non-profit corporation, nor shall said chapters and provisions apply to any other non-profit corporation owned or controlled by the commission.
