As we discussed on the telephone on January 15, 1998, I am providing you an update on the lease discussions between the Tasty and the Cambridge Savings Bank.

The Bank has been actively seeking tenants for the Read Block restoration project for the last two months or so. Although we have had significant interest in the project and preliminary discussions with prospective tenants, we do not yet have a commitment that will allow us to firm up our tenant plan. Without this firm tenant plan, we believe it is premature to discuss specific lease terms with the Tasty. Once we have this plan, we will discuss specifics with the Tasty.

I discussed our tenancy situation with Peter Haddad, and we mutually agreed to postpone our scheduled meeting of January 15, 1998 and to reschedule the meeting for February 12, 1998. We hope to have more information relative to the tenant plan at that time.
