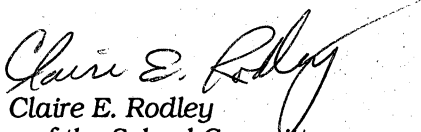
Dear Members of the City Council:

Fitzgerald Student Injured

Please be notified that it was just brought to our attention that a Fitzgerald School 4th grade, male student was hit by a car at approximately 5:30 P.M. last evening, Tuesday, April 7, 1998 while on his way to a baseball game at Rindge Field.

The child was taken by ambulance to Cambridge Hospital where he was evaluated, and it was determined that he suffered only minor bumps and bruises.

His parents kept him home today to recover from the trauma of being struck by the car. It is their intention that their son will return to school tomorrow, April 9th.

No incident report was filed by the Fitzgerald administrators because the accident occurred at a non-school related activity, well after school hours and not on school grounds.
