ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to the Cambridge-Ellis School for the erection of a banner from the Saint James Episcopal Church at 1991 Mass. Avenue, across Beech Street to the Long Funeral Home.

Provided that, before erecting the above named banner, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department: that said banner be erected no less than 16 feet above grade to insure the free flow of vehicular and truck traffic, and that said petitioner file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.) Dollars conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge for all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner.
