In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Seventy Three.

An Ordinance amending the Ordinance
relating to - Streets -

It is ordained by the City Council of Cambridge
as follows.

Chapter Twenty-five of the revised Ordinances
is hereby amended, by the addition of the following
words to the sixteenth section thereof,

Whenever any street shall be opened by the
Water Board, the Sewer Department, the Cambridge
Gas Light Company, or by any person for any
lawful purpose, the Superintendent of Streets
shall prevent any unnecessary obstruction while
the work is in progress, and shall see that the
same is repaired and put in good order when
the work is completed.

If the street shall not be so repaired to his
acceptance, he shall forthwith put the same
in good order, and shall render a bill for the
expense of such repair to the Department, Corporation
or person, whose duty it was to repair said
street.
