Please be advised the Marriott Hotel will start operating a taxi call light. The purpose of this light is to let drivers know a taxi is needed at the stand on the Broadway side of the Hotel. The light is located on the wall of the hotel next to the Characters awning on Main Street. The light is white with taxi written on it.

The new procedure for the use of the Marriott stand will be as followed. Taxi cabs will line up on Main street by the Characters awning and wait for the call light to be turned on. Once the light is on any taxi on Main St. may proceed to Broadway.
