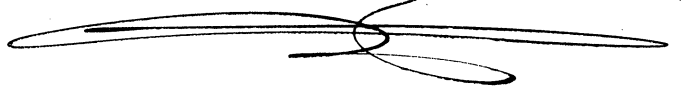


Cambridge, June 13th 1870

To the Honorable, the Mayor and Aldermen,
of the City of Cambridge.

The undersigned respectfully prays that permission be granted to him to construct a bulk-head communicating with the cellar of store T:1. in his building, situated on Harvard Square Cambridge, and known as the "New Harvard Block"; said bulk-head to be below the Western window in front of said store, on Harvard Square, and to project out from the base of the building not more than three feet six inches leaving the space of five feet three inches from the outer edge of the proposed bulk-head, to the outer edge of the curb-stone of the side-walk, in front of said building.
