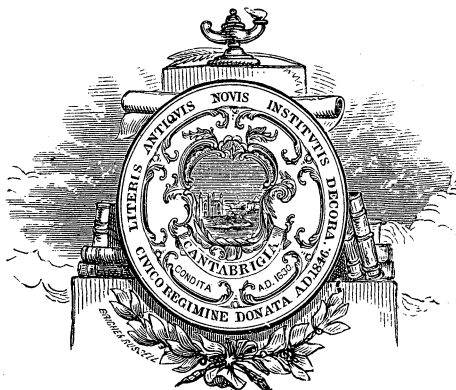


Ordered, That damages occasioned by said widening be estimated and awarded as follows:

In Board of Aldermen, *July 4th* 1871

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that *Mount Auburn Street and Brattle Square* should be widened on the northwesterly side thereof

by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on *said Street and Square,* now or late of *Welch Bigelow & Co.,* as lies between the present lines of the same, and

~~as is included between the~~ *red* lines shown on a plan of *said Square and* Street, drawn by the City Engineer, dated *November 1870* and now before this

Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said *Mount Auburn Street.* *and Brattle Square*

Ordered, That *five days*, be allowed to the persons whose land is
taken for said *widening* for the removal of *the fences* standing
on the land so taken as aforesaid.
