She has been a tireless advocate for our city's children; and

WHEREAS: Carolyn's many affiliations include: the Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development, the National Council for Teachers of English, the Massachusetts Computer Users in Education, the Massachusetts Teachers Association, the National Association for Female Executives, Patriots' Trail Girl Scout Council, the NAACP, and the Women's Leadership Forum of the Democratic National Committee; now therefore be it
