WHEREAS: The Cambridge Food Pantry Network/CEOC, which currently feeds more than one thousand families each month, has announced that it will hold a citywide "Feed the Children" Food Drive on May 5-20, 1991 to feed the growing number of hungry residents in Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: More than two thousand pregnant women, mothers, babies, and young children are kept on waiting lists for special food programs and more than three thousand children in Cambridge suffer from inadequate nutrition; and

WHEREAS: This food drive will begin on May 5, 1991, the date for the annual Project Bread Walk for Hunger; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council proclaims May 5, 1991 "Walk for Hunger" Day in Cambridge and urges the full support of all of Cambridge's residents to support the hungry and ensure the success of this and other food drives; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to the Cambridge Food Pantry Network and to Project Bread.
