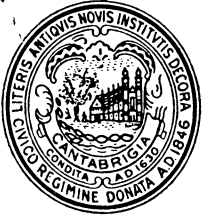

In accordance with city procedures, this is to request an appropriation of \$662.00 to be distributed as follows:


B22, Medical	\$222.00

Mr. O'Connor, while on official library duty, on 7 February 1972, fell in the library parking lot. He bruised his shoulder and required medical and hospital attention.

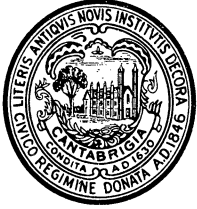
The above amounts represent an estimate on Workmen's Compensation as well as medical and hospital expenses. Enclosed for your information is the standard form report of injury.


To the Honorable, the City Council,
