- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to obtain from the Arts Council an explanation as to why they did not request permission of this City Council to excavate the sidewalk in front of City Hall and erect the chimes which have now become a source of neighborhood irritation; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Arts Council to conduct a neighborhood survey to determine whether or not these chimes should remain at their present location and/or can they be muffled in such a way as to reduce the level of noise; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Arts Council to attend the meeting of the City Council on June 2, 1980 and to submit the above report to the City Council at that time.
