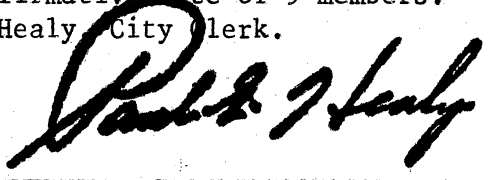

- WHEREAS: This City Council, as was the world, was shocked and saddened upon learning of the tragic deaths of 269 passengers aboard a Korean airplane, caused by a Russian fighter plane shooting the commercial airliner out of the sky; and
- WHEREAS: This total disregard for life should not and cannot be tolerated under any circumstances, since this outrageous act violates everything for which this country and the Constitution stands; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest condolences to all the families of those who were passengers of that ill-fated Flight "007" and to further urge our national leaders and international allies to do all that they can to make certain that such a sad and unforgivable act never reoccurs.
