- WHEREAS: The Armory Shelter for the homeless is scheduled to be closed on April 30; and
- WHEREAS: Other shelters also will close, leaving the homeless in a continuing vulnerable condition; and
- WHEREAS: The City Manager is scheduled to report to the City Council on a permanent shelter plan; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to negotiate with the State to extend the use of the Armory as a shelter for the homeless until a more long-term action plan to meet the needs of the homeless is adopted; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to prepare an alternative plan or plans that would result in a long term shelter facility for homeless people in the event that the City cannot successfully re-negotiate with the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for an extension of the use of the Concord Avenue Armory.
