At 10:29 p.m. on Saturday, June 13, 1998, a 911 call was received by Cambridge Emergency Communication reporting that "there was a fire next to a car on my street (19 Sacramento Place) and that somebody's out there right now putting it out." Engine 4 responded at 10:36 p.m. and any fire present was extinguished.

Cambridge Police responded and took a report from Peggy Averitte, who stated that an unknown person set fire to a newspaper next to her motor vehicle and placed a lighter underneath the car. Cambridge Police Detective Dwyer responded and the matter is under investigation by the Cambridge Police Department and the Cambridge Fire Arson Squad.
