Said amount includes a special appropriation for Seventeen Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-eight Dollars and Forty-eight Cents (\$17,798.48) authorized by the City Council on June 12, 1917. The amount so appropriated being ~~made~~ ^{appropriation for} a part of the annual ~~estimates by~~ the Police Department for the financial year 1917-18 and to supersede the appropriation order for the same department passed by the City Council under date of June 26, 1917.
