- ORDERED: That the City Council be informed that a life long citizen of Cambridge wants it to be known that ten or twelve apartments consisting of five houses can be transplanted from a land area to another land area if the City can provide land for such a transplanting; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to work with said citizen in order to add these apartments, which are vacant to the housing stock in the City of Cambridge; and be it further
- ORDERED: That copies of this order be sent by the City Manager to the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority and the Cambridge Community Development Department for consideration and recommendations for the future use of these dwelling units; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Rent Control Board to report regarding the possible future use of these dwelling units for housing; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager, after conferring with the above agencies, departments and boards, is hereby requested to report his findings and recommendations to this City Council regarding the future disposition of these properties.
