WHEREAS: The Mayor has set up a special committee regarding the evaluation of the Auditor's Office; and

WHEREAS: Many of the former duties of the Auditor are now under the auspices of the Treasurer's Office; and

WHEREAS: It appears that the present Auditor will be retiring during the course of this year; and

WHEREAS: There are certain statutory and/or charter duties that are required of the Auditor's Office; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the Mayor's special committee that has been set up to study the Auditor's Office be instructed to consider the financial impact of dissolving the office and making the necessary legal amendments to do so and to advise this City Council as to what amendments are necessary and whether it would be a cost saving to the city if the department was dissolved and any statutory or charter obligation which could not be discharged by legal amendments be reassigned or given to an outside independent contractor.
