Resolved, That in the opinion of this Board the public convenience as well as the great expense involved render it highly inexpedient that the grade of Front St., as established by orders approved 20 July 1888 and 25 July 1889 laying out said street, should be changed.

And it is hereby

Ordered, That the City Solicitor be directed to protest on behalf of the city of Cambridge against any such change, and that the Joint Committee on Roads and Bridges, the Joint Special Committee on the Harvard Bridge and the Superintendent of Streets be also requested to attend the hearing before the Railroad Commissioners in Boston on Monday, 2 December next at 10 A. M.
