I also wish to hear Donald Drisdell's explanation as to why he and other member of the City's Law Department have refused to advise the City Manager to formally enforce the City's License and why he and other members of the City's Law Department have intentionally ~~delayed~~ interfered with the rights of the Cablesubscribers and my rights to recover money owed us.
