This office represents Ms. Emma Lynskey of 167 Magazine Street, Cambridge, MA.

Notice is hereby given to the City of Cambridge in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Annotated, Chapter 84, Section 18, as amended. I am advising the City of Cambridge that at approximately 1:30 P.M. on Tuesday, March 13, 1979, Ms. Emma Lynskey was caused to fall by a defect in the public way in the City of Cambridge, to wit: a cement sidewalk raised approximately three (3) to four (4) inches in height above the normal walkway for pedestrians. This occurred in front of the premises located at 1705 Massachusetts Avenue, more particularly described by three (3) feet beside the side entrance of the premises and six and one-half (6½) feet from the sidewalk, one hundred (100) feet from the intersection of Massachusetts Avenue and Garfield Street on the southerly side in a westerly direction.

A description of the injuries to Ms. Lynskey are as follows: six (6) stitches on her face above her eye, one (1) broken finger and injuries to her body all for which I am holding the City of Cambridge liable.
