WHEREAS: Cities across the country have planned activities to celebrate National Arts Week and to commemorate a week designated to focus the public's attention on the arts in various communities; and

WHEREAS: The Cambridge Arts Council, eager to participate actively in National Arts Week, is encouraging the public to attend local cultural events, including: "The Discovery Re-Examined", a visual art exhibition in City Hall re-examining the history and legacy of the European incursion into the Americas; an exhibition at City Hall Annex celebrating the winners of Gallery 57's Third Annual Juried Exhibition Contest; the first Cambridge Festival of Irish Cultural Heritage, an open air festival of music dance and the arts sponsored by the Cambridge Arts Council and the Irish Immigration Center at Canal Park on Sunday, September 20th; Longy School of Music's Septemberfest Celebration; the Cambridge Center for Adult Education's Fall Festival of One-Act Plays; American Repertory Theater's Fall Festival; the New School of Music Community Music Concert Series; "Children's Creative Work in Wood", an artist-in-residency program by Alice L. Turkel at the New Program in Cambridgeport, funded by the Arts Lottery Program of the Massachusetts Cultural Council as administered by the Cambridge Arts Council; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council proclaims the period from September 20, 1992 through September 26, 1992 to be WEEK OF THE ARTS IN CAMBRIDGE, and urges the people of Cambridge to take advantage of the events planned by the Cambridge Arts Council and the many other Cambridge arts organizations; and be it further
