This office has been in correspondence with the Tenant Senate of the Cambridge Housing Authority over the progress of the modernization program which effects the housing projects in their administrative, physical and social aspects for which it was authorized.

For HUD to effectively deal with the Cambridge Housing Authority to provide housing for families of low-income and to expedite the modernization program, a full board compliment is essential. We urge, therefore, that you use your good office to expeditiously appoint qualified citizens for service on the Board.

This is in response to your April 17 letter addressed to Administrator Barry, concerning the Cambridge Housing Authority's administration of the modernization program.

You recall that staff members from this office met with you and Mr. Hovenian and other members of the council on matters pertaining to the progress of the program and in terms of the content of your letter. Furthermore, in a letter of April 24, to the Authority, following the meeting, this office strongly urged that the modernization program be fully implemented without delay in its social, administrative and physical aspects for which it was authorized.

However, to effectively implement the program a full complement of the board's membership is necessary, therefore we suggest that the council use its efforts to have the existing three vacancies filled as soon as possible.

You may be assured of our fullest cooperation with the new board of commissioners and to continue to follow closely the progress of the modernization program to see that it is carried out effectively and expeditiously.

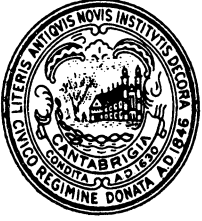


