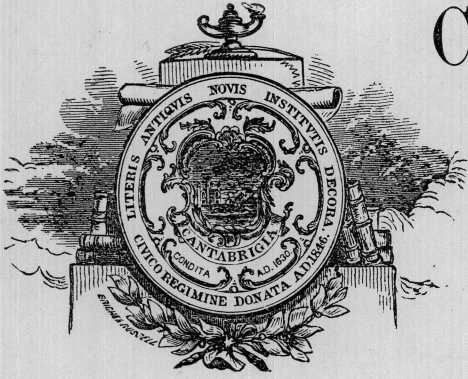




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

April 30, 1873

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Harrison Street
from Main St. to Washington St.

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *thirty feet*
in width between

Main and Washington Streets

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *J. G. Chase*
City Engineer, as plan of the
Washington St. District

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid.
