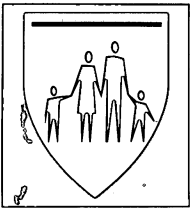

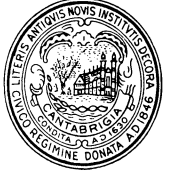

I am writing at the request of Russ Higley, City Solicitor of Cambridge, MA. Mr. Higley asked me to outline the relationship my architectural firm, King/Warner Associates, has had with Cambridge Hospital and Continental Realty Trust, the developer interested in building a new parking garage for the Hospital.

As you know my firm was selected in June of 1984 to provide architectural services for the renovation of Cambridge Hospital's outpatient clinics. Our contract is for a two year period commencing on July 1, 1984 and ending June 30, 1986.

In August of 1984 Continental Realty Trust retained my firm to develop preliminary architectural plans for a parking garage to be leased by the Hospital. My firm has been working with Continental Realty Trust on this project intermittently over the past two years. Because of the nature of this project, we have also interfaced directly with Hospital and City officials.
