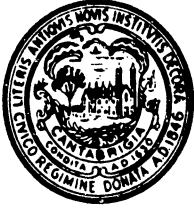

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$4,000 in the Grant Fund of the Human Services Salary & Wages Account (\$3,500) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$500) from the Federal Center for Substance Abuse Prevention, through IMPACT of North Charles, Inc. These funds will be utilized by the Cambridge Prevention Coalition (CPC), a Community Partnership Grant to provide alcohol, tobacco and other drug prevention training for Cambridge youth from November 1, 1997 to June 30, 1998. These funds will be used to pay for CPC staff and program operating costs.
