Dear Members of the Council:

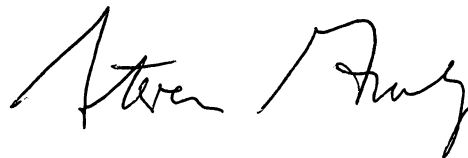
I am a property owner in the area affected by zoning changes along Mass. Ave.

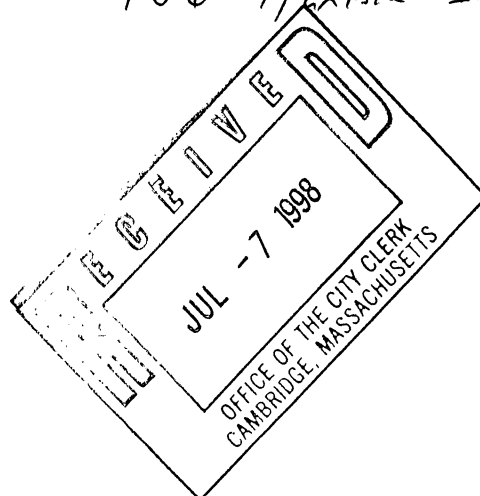
