An Ordinance in addition to  
an Ordinance relating to Drains  
and Common Sewers

Be it Ordained by the City  
Council of the City of Cambridge  
as follows:—

SECT. I. No particular drain shall hereafter be entered into any main drain or common sewer constructed or maintained by the City, except by and under the Superintendance of the Superintendent of Drains, who shall cause the said entry to be made upon the request of any person entitled to the same, and at the expense of the party making such request

SECT. II. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed
