A Brief History of the Women's Choir "Kir Stefan" of Smederevo, Serbia

In May 1994, the Choir won a Bronze Medal in the Competition of the Youth Choirs of Serbia in Novi Pazar.

In May 1995, the Choir won a Gold Medal in the Competition of Youth Choirs of Serbia in Novi Pazar.

In September, 1995, the Choir opened the International Choir Festival in Kardica, Greece.

In March, 1996, the Choir participated in the International Choir Competition in Riva Del Garda, Italy, winning the Silver Medal in "Sacred Music" and the Bronze medal in "Folk Music."

In July, 1996, the Choir won first place in Niš, Yugoslavia, in the "Sacred Music" category.

In May, 1997, the Choir participated at the International Smetana Choir Competition in Litomysl, Czech Republic, winning the Gold Medal in the "Sacred Music" category and the Gold Medal for traditional (folk) music.

In October, 1997, the Choir participated at the International Choir Competition in Canto sul Garda, Italy, and won the Gold Medal in musica tradizionale, and the Gold Medal in musica religiosa.

In May, 1998, in Pohlheim, Germany, "Kir Stefan" choir won the Gold Medal in musica religiosa.

In October, 1998, the Choir participated at the International Choir Competition in "Shirat Hayamim", Netanya, Israel and won the Gold Medal in the Folk Music category.

The conductor of the Choir is Professor Milan Ilic. He was born on 22/08/1965, in Smederevo and has been conducting the Choir since its inception.
