ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Director of Traffic and Parking, the Chief of Police and the Commissioner of Public Works to take the required action and to issue all necessary permits in connection with the Portuguese-American Communities of Greater Boston, relative to the "Day of Portugal" parade to be held on Sunday, June 5, 1988, from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., in order to accomplish the following:

1. The parade route is projected to be from Second Street (Cambridge) to the park of St. Anthony's Church, via Cambridge Street, Inman Square, Hampshire Street, and Cardinal Medeiros Avenue, where there will be food and refreshments after the parade; also folk dancing groups and bands will provide rich and unique entertainment into the evening.
2. The use of one flat bed truck, with driver, to provide transportation for the Cambridge Rindge & Latin School band.
3. The raising of the Portuguese and American flags at City Hall on the morning of June 5, 1988 at 10:00 a.m. and remaining raised until June 20, 1988.
4. The participation, where possible, of the prestigious members of the Cambridge City Council, Cambridge School Committee, Cambridge Police, Cambridge Fire and Cambridge Hospital Departments.
5. A banner across Cambridge Street from the light pole at 819 Cambridge Street to the tree in front of the Harrington School from May 17, 1988 to Sunday, June 5, 1988.

; and be it further

ORDERED:

That any permits granted for street closures and parades, as well as other festival activities be subject to the condition that fire lanes be kept open at all times for the safety of the public, as determined by the Chief of the Fire Department.
