WHEREAS: Former Mayor Alfred Vellucci extended his support for "Food Not Bombs" to the then Mayor of San Francisco in a council order some years ago; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council renew its appreciation and support of the work Keith McHenry does to feed hungry people in our country and urges the city of San Francisco to refrain from unjust prosecution or harassment of Mr. McHenry.
