RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Regan family on behalf of the entire City Council.

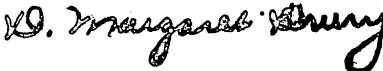

WHEREAS: Donald served from 1981 to 1985 as treasury secretary during President Ronald Reagan's first administration and then as President Reagan's chief of staff throughout his second term; and

WHEREAS: Donald was the beloved son of the late William F. and Kathleen (Ahern) Regan; and
