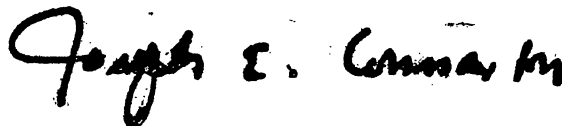

Attached is an order requesting the transfer of \$11,900.00 in the General Fund from the Human Rights Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (Professional & Technical Services) to the Human Rights Salary & Wages Account (worktime/non position account).
