IN CITY COUNCIL

September 17, 1984

WHEREAS: This City Council is in receipt of a communication from Sally Alcorn, Executive Director of the Harvard Square Business Association, requesting permission to suspend three banners to commemorate the sixth annual Oktoberfest in Harvard Square; and

WHEREAS: Said banners are to be constructed of light-weight nylon and to be suspended by means of ropes through the hems at the top and bottom of each banner; and

WHEREAS: The petitioner requests permission to suspend one of the banners measuring 4 by 35 feet across the intersection of Brattle Street and John F. Kennedy Street and further requests permission to suspend the two remaining banners across Massachusetts Avenue, east of Harvard Square and across John F. Kennedy Street between the "Garage" and Crimson Travel, pending approval from the respective landlords; now therefore be it

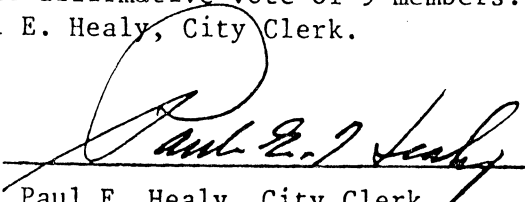
ORDERED: That in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Sally Alcorn, Executive Director of the Harvard Square Business Association for the erection of three banners at the aforementioned locations; and be it further

ORDERED: That said permit be granted subject to the condition that a copy of the bond executed by the petitioner covering exigencies related to said Harvard Square Business Association's occasional use of banners commemorating outdoor events and freeing the petitioner from posting a special bond with the City Clerk, be filed with the Office of the City Clerk prior to the issuance of said banner permit by the Commissioner of Public Works.

Dear Mr. Mayor:

We would like permission from the City Council to suspend three banners to commemorate our sixth annual Oktoberfest in Harvard Square. The banners would be constructed of light-weight nylon and be suspended by means of ropes through the hems at the top and bottom of each of three banners. One of the banners, measuring 4 by 35 feet, would be suspended across the intersection of Brattle and John F. Kennedy street; the others would be placed across Mass. avenue east of Harvard Square and across John F. Kennedy street between the "Garage" and Crimson Travel, pending approval by the respective landlords.

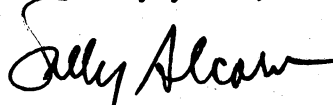
Our business office policy with Storer, Damon, and Lund covers exigencies related to our occasional use of banners commemorating our outdoor events and frees us from the necessity of posting a special bond in this case.

Next year, by the way, the Harvard Square Business Association celebrates its 75th anniversary -- which we like to think of as our "banner" year. In conjunction with our anniversary, we would like to be able to sport banners in Harvard Square to celebrate several major public events sponsored by our Association.

Please let me know whether the Council is amenable or not inclined to approve our request to suspend banners for the Oktoberfest and for our anniversary celebrations in 1985.
